Upfront Rules

Athletes and Adults

- Everyone is responsible for safety
- No foul language
- No bullying
- We do not lie, cheat, or steal. Nor tolerate those that do
- Treat everyone with respect
- No One on One contact with youth
- Be at least 1 hour early for any match
- Have a good time!!

Other Rules

- This is a quiet sport
- Do not pick up another person's gun without asking
- Be careful around the gun racks
- Never walk in front of low house window when open
- Never mix ammo
- No horseplay on the fields

SCTP National Championship Promo

- Open to all SCTP registered youth
- No qualification to attend
- Held in Cardinal Shooting Center in Marengo, OH
- Held in Mid July of 2024

4-H Nationals

- Open to 4-H registered youth
- Must qualify to attend (application process)
- You may only attend once
- Held in Grand Island, Nebraska (right hand side of the state)
- Held in End of June, first part of July of 2024

Athletes Head Outside

- Coaches and Sr. Athletes will take youth to Trap fields for a little shooting.
- If you do not have a gun or ammo Young Guns has you covered for now.

Our Schedule

- Program runs from Sept to May
 - July if youth decide to go to Nationals in Ohio
- · We Practice on Saturday,
 - but not on the 2nd Saturday of every month
 - 2nd Saturday is dedicated to registered (scored)
 Trap shoots or 5-Stand Shoots

Our Competition Schedule

- Two qualifiers (skeet and trap) 100 targets
- Three sporting clays events. 100 targets each
- Three multi-discipline events (skeet, trap, sporting clays)
 - Multi-discipline are multi-day events requiring travel to either Edgefield, SC or Savannah, AG
- One National Sporting Clays Event
 - Back Woods Quail Club (Georgetown area)
- Two national events
 - SCTP Nationals
 - 4-H Nationals (invitation only)

Program Base Fees

- Young Guns: \$40 admin fee
- All youth must join 4-H and SCTP
 - 4-H is \$15 online registration
 - SCTP is \$25 for youth and \$35 for coaches. Online registration.

Other Estimated Costs

Not including ammo, gun, food, transportation...

- Practice
 - Skeet and Trap: \$9.00
 - Sporting Clays: \$20 Flat Fee
- Matches
 - 4-H/SCTP: \$35 \$55





Expectations

- Be active in Young Guns
 - Active means:
 - Attend practices
 - Participate in skeet, trap, sporting clays, or five stand
 - Attend at least one club workday
 - Maximum effort
- If you are going to compete this is your sport



Competing and Commitment

- Competition is not for those new to shooting sports. 100 shots are required
- Competition is a commitment to the team, squad and others
- Competition takes discipline and dedication to yourself and others
- Squads are 3 to 5 people
 - If a squad is short a person then the squad is automatically short 100 targets

RSVPing / Cost

- Getting folks registered takes a great deal of planning
- Up and midnight for coaches not uncommon
- When we shoot is dictated by when we register
- If a member of a squad drops from an event they are still responsible for the fees
- Payment will be requested and required before youth are registered for an event

Practices

- 9:00 12:30 on Saturdays (Minus 2nd Saturday)
 - 2nd Saturday is dedicated to registered (scored) Trap shoots or 5-Stand
 Shoots
- Meet at the Skeet Houses. (our logo above it)
- Youth must sign in

- Skeet and Trap
 - Tokens used for practice
 - Token machine in the first clubhouse
 - We pay \$3 a round (member rate)
 - Pay as you go
 - Tokens are good forever
- Sporting Clays
 - \$20 flat fee to shoot sporting clays
 - Must pay before shooting
